DIY RECIPE AND FORMULATION FOR MAKING 10 LITERS OF GLASS CLEANER

Ingredients:

- 8 liters of distilled water
- 1 litre of white vinegar
- 500 ml of rubbing alcohol (isopropyl alcohol)
- 300 ml of liquid dish soap (choose a mild, non-abrasive variety)
